

1- CONGRESS VENUE

Hotel Dei Cavalieri Piazza Giuseppe Missori, 1, 20123 Milano MI



2- HOW TO REACH THE CONGRESS VENUE

Public transport is the most convenient way to reach the hotel, as the main stop is directly on the piazza.

Metro

- Closest Station: Missori (M3 Yellow Line)
 - The metro station exit is directly in front of the hotel entrance.
 - From Milano Centrale Train Station: Take the M3 (Yellow Line) towards San Donato and get off at Missori (about a 7-minute ride).
 - From Duomo Square: Take the M3 (Yellow Line) towards San Donato and get off at Missori (only a 1-minute ride/short walk).
- Other Nearby Stations:
 - o Duomo (M1 Red Line & M3 Yellow Line) is a 5-minute walk away.
 - Santa Sofia (M4 Blue Line) is a 6-minute walk away.

Bus & Tram

The hotel is also served by several bus and tram lines, with stops right on Piazza Missori. See the ATM Milano website (Milan transports company) to navigate more easily and find the fastes route to the Congress venue.

- Trams: Lines 15, 19, and 24 have stops nearby (Missori M3 stop).
- Buses: Lines 50, 57, 60, 61, 65, and 94 have stops close by (Missori M3 stop).

From Milan Airports

Airport	PUDIIC Transport Route	Approx. Time

iviaipensa	Take the Malpensa Express Train to Cadorna Station, then switch to the M1 Metro (Red Line) to Duomo, and then take the M3 Metro (Yellow Line) one stop to Missori.	50–60 minutes
	Take an Airport Bus Shuttle (Terravision, Orio Shuttle, etc.) to Milano Centrale Station, then follow the directions from Milano Centrale above.	60–90 minutes

By Car & Parking

Driving to the hotel is possible, but please be aware of central Milan's restricted traffic zone. Area C

The Hotel Dei Cavalieri is located within Milan's central restricted traffic zone, known as Area C.

- Charge: If you drive into the area from Monday to Friday between 7:30 a.m. and 7:30 p.m., you
 must purchase and activate an Area C entrance ticket (€7.50).
- Activation: The hotel reception staff can assist you with activating this ticket upon check-in.
- Exemptions: Access is free on Saturdays, Sundays, and public holidays.

Parking

The hotel does not have parking on-site but offers a convenient, affiliated garage nearby, feel free to ask Defoe (info@defoe.it) or the hotel for information.

- Thursday Oct 23rd: A coffee break will take place in the afternoon from 15.40-16.10
- Friday Oct 24th: Morning and afternoon coffee breaks and lunch in the exhibition area.

4- SIMULTANEOUS TRANSLATION (Headphones Requirement)

Simultaneous translation will be available (English-Italian and English-french). Please note that, in order to be able to listen to it you will need a pair of headphones connected to your personal phone, no headphones will be available onsite. The simultaneous translation will be available through a dedicated QR code that will be displayed before the relevant session.

If you need any assistance do not hesitate to ask the staff at the registration desk. An open Wifi is available at the Venue named Hotel Wifi.


The Meeting has been accredited for 100 participants by the Italian Health Ministry. CME credits are available for specialists in Urology, Gynecology and Obstetrics, General Surgery, Neurology, Internal Medicine, Gastroenterology, Radiodiagnostics, Anesthesiology; Nurses, Midwives, Physiotherapists. To obtain Italian CME credits valid for the Italian Health Ministry, participants need to attend 90% of scientific sessions, having their attendance verified (having personal badges scanned) and pass the evaluation test after the event (75% of correct answers is the minimum passing score). Please note that there is only one attempt available to complete the test.

- 2) Login with the credentials and password that you can find printed on the backside of your badge
